Mini show Rules:

1. The mini show is sanctioned by the Miniature Dairy Goat Association. MDGA rules will govern.
2. Eligibility to participate in a MDGA sanctioned show requires that you be a current member of the Miniature Dairy Goat Association.
3. The order of the show is subject to change.
4. The Jr. Doe show is sanctioned for Mini LaMancha and All Other Mini.
5. The Sr. Doe show is sanctioned for Mini LaMancha and All Other Mini.
6. Entry Fees: \$6 per goat if paid by June 1st. After June 1st, entries will be \$12.00.
7. Base Date for computing age is June 7th.
8. For all entries in a sanctioned show, either a registration certificate or an email from the registrar showing that an application for registration has been submitted to the registry must be presented to the show secretary or appointed trustee at the time of check-in.
9. Grand and Reserve Winners will be photographed for MDGA website & Facebook pages.
10. To compete in an MDGA sanctioned "Experimental" show, a miniature dairy goat is not required to be registered with MDGA but may be registered with another official miniature dairy goat registry. If such an animal is awarded Grand Champion of its breed, the animal's owner will have two weeks from the show date to register the goat with MDGA in order for the animal to receive the winning leg; otherwise, the leg will be awarded to the Reserve Champion as long as the Reserve Champion is registered with MDGA.
11. The sanction requirements to qualify for a championship leg are a minimum of 8 animals and 2 exhibitors per sanction.

ADGA – Show Rules

1. The Nigerian Dwarf Goat show is sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association. ADGA rules will govern.
2. Only American Dairy Goat Association, American Goat Society and Canadian Goat Society registered, recorded or applied for animals may be shown.
3. The order of the show is subject to change.
4. The Junior and Senior doe shows are separately sanctioned.
5. Entry Fees: \$6 per goat if paid by June 1st. After June 1st, entries will be \$12.00.
6. Base Date for computing age is June 7th.
7. A registration certificate is required for all animals six months of age or older. A registration certificate or a stamped duplicate application showing the date received by the ADGA office is required for all animals under six months of age.
8. Animals with natural horns shall not be shown.
9. Grand and Reserve Winners will be photographed for website & Facebook pages.
10. The sanction requirements to qualify for a championship leg are a minimum of 10 animals and 2 exhibitors per sanction.

MISC Show Rules

1. Goats must meet Kentucky health requirements. No visible signs of abscesses or other contagious diseases (pinkeye, soremouth, ringworm, etc.) will be allowed. All animals must have a valid health certificate. All goats must comply with Kentucky Department of Agriculture rules.
2. **Pens are not provided.** There are plenty of places to set up temporary tie outs or portable pens. (pen clean up is pending information from fair personnel)
3. There are multiple water hydrants for your use and hoses will be available to fill water buckets.
4. No dogs are allowed in barn or show arena.
5. Hart County Fair Board, KY Quad Mini Squad or any volunteer personnel are not responsible for any loss or accidents related to the show.
